Remember to add detail to your answers, think "why?" or "how?"

Habitat	A place where a plant or an animal lives.
Organism	A single living thing.
Species	A type of living thing.
Community	A group of interacting species sharing a habitat.
Producer	Organisms that produce their own food.
Consumer	Organisms that consume food.
Predator	Animals that hunt and eat other animals.
Prey	Animals that are hunted and eaten by other animals.
Herbivore	Animals that eat only plants.
Omnivore	Animals that eat both plants and other animals.
Carnivore	Animals that eat only other animals.
