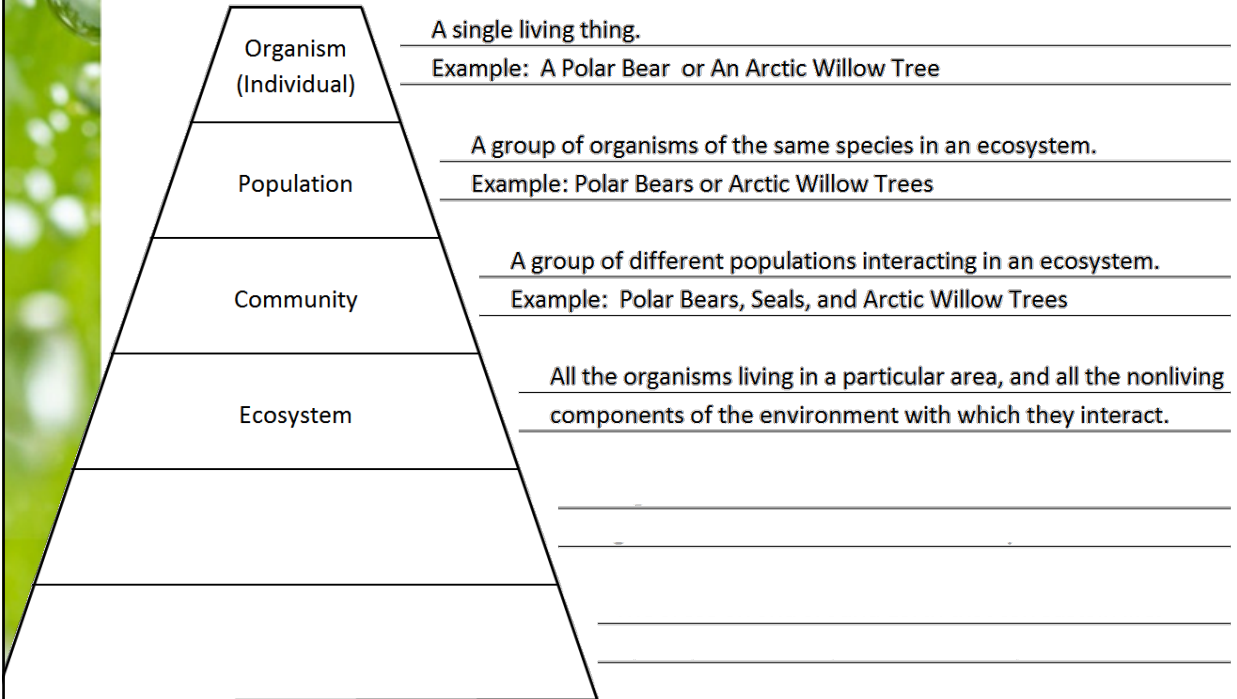
# Ecosystems
