 - Hot Glue Gun



Tool Safety

With each tool there will be a safety reminder sheet. When you take the tool, you are also to obtain a copy of the sheet and take it with you and keep it at your work station. When you return the tool, you are to also return the safety reminder sheet. Here are a few examples of what the sheets will look like:



*A copy of all of these will be put online if you would like to review them.

Remember:

- Always wear your safety glasses, even when it is not you doing the work.
- Always wear closed toed shoes no sandals to be worn at any time.
- Long hair is always tied back, in a bun or braided if past shoulders.
- Only one person uses any one tool at a time. Help can be given verbally, but not physically.
- If you don't know what to do ASK.

Design Ideas
